- A one-page itemized budget indicating expected expenses, specifying how much money you
 are requesting from the Carol Raymond French Fund, and explaining how you plan to meet
 total expenses with or without such funding;
- Your most recent unofficial UNM transcript;
- Two letters of recommendation, at least one of which must be from a faculty member of French at UNM.
