Research, Teaching and Service Interests

I have been teaching Chinese as a second language since 2010. In my Chinese language classes, I adopted a student-centered approach in which students are given plenty of opportunities to actually communicate in Chinese meaningfully. I am very passionate about teaching language and culture, and willing to work with all students who are interested in learning Chinese. Students often appreciate my energetic teaching style as well as great patience.

Before joining UNM, I taught a good variety of undergraduate Chinese language courses in the College of William and Mary (Williamsburg, VA), including regular beginning level to upper-intermediate level classes, Chinese for heritage speakers, summer intensive classes, and beginning business Chinese (for alumni). I also taught Chinese classes at all levels including AP Chinese with Virtual Virginia, a fully online course program provided by the Virginia Department of Education.

My postgraduate studies focused on curriculum and instructions in foreign languages with a special concentration on Chinese language education. My teaching and research interests focus on teaching Chinese as a second language, including the following areas:

- Chinese phonetic pedagogy
- Chinese grammar pedagogy
- Chinese behavioral culture
- Task-based and Project-based language learning
- Curriculum design
- Technology integration and online learning

My co-authored textbook *Acting Chinese: An Intermediate-Advanced Course in Discourse and Behavioral Culture* was published in 2021 with Routledge.

Since joining LCL in 2016, I have been constantly serving as the Chinese Program Undergraduate Advisor. In the meanwhile, I have been serving as the Faculty Advisor to the Chinese Language and Culture Club since fall 2016. In Spring 2023 I was elected a Faculty Senator to serve on the Faculty Senate in the upcoming years.

In September 2018 I founded the Chinese Language Teachers Association of New Mexico, and served as the inaugural president for two terms, from 2018 to 2020 (first term) and from 2020 to 2022 (second term). The purpose of the CLTA-NM is to promote quality teaching of Chinese language and culture at all educational levels, to enhance career development and provide a networking platform for Chinese language teachers, and to disseminate pedagogical development and innovations in the State of New Mexico.

In 2019 I joined the Board of the New Mexico Organization of Language Educators (NMOLE) and have been served on the Board. In September 2020 I was nominated the President-Elect of NMOLE, and in September 2021 I was elected President. In the 2022-2023 school year, I served as the immediate Past-President. It has been a great honor to serve in the leadership team of NMOLE and to bring positive impact to New Mexican language educators.
